Route 62



Brace yourself for more bubbles and fun on the bus as we pass through cute little towns along the famous Route 62. The first stop is Calitzdorp, then on to the gay-village of Barrydale with craft beer tasting, galleries and divine coffee shops and arts and craft stores. The last stop of the day, not too far from Barrydale is Montagu. After dinner, a lesbian tour guide will conduct a fun, crazy (and not so scary) ghost tour, telling wonderful stories of the little town.
